58	Super Tuscan, Ruffino Modus 2006 (Tuscany, Italy) <i>Blend of 50% Sangiovese and equal parts of Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon to create a rich and smooth balance with cherry and blackberry notes and a soft vanilla finish.</i>		\$40
59	Super Tuscan, Tenuta Del Terriccio, Tassinaia (Tuscany, Italy) <i>Combination of near equal parts Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes, creates a big, structure wine with black currant and herb aromas with cedar, and vanilla notes before a rich and round plum and cherry finish.</i>		\$62
60	Barolo, Michele Chiarlo 2003 (Piedmont, Italy) <i>A rich, robustly full-bodied wine with a deep, penetrating bouquet and velvety texture.</i>		\$74
61	Cabernet Sauvignon, Hess (Napa Valley, California) <i>Aged in new French oak, with soft notes of blackberry and sweet molasses and a soft chocolaty finish.</i>	\$8	\$28
62	Cabernet Sauvignon, Sequoia Grove 2006 (Napa Valley, California) <i>Aromas of ripe cherry and blackberry with a bit of mocha and cocoa. The fruit intertwines lovingly with the oak, hints of clove, black pepper and spice with soft and supple tannins creating an endless finish.</i>		\$62
63	Campofiorin Rosso Del Veronese, "Ripasso" (Veneto, Italy) <i>Made from Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes capturing baked cherries and plum flavors with a hint of vanilla and cinnamon.</i>		\$27
